Declaration

on the application of Regulation (EU) 2023/988 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 10 May 2023 on general product safety amending Regulation (EU) No. 1025/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council and Directive (EU) 2020/1828 of the European Parliament and of the Council and repealing Directive 2001/95/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council and Council Directive 87/357/EEC.

Dear Sir/Madam,

Regulation (EU) 2023/988 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 10 May 2023 on general product safety (**GPSR Regulation**), amending Regulation (EU) No. 1025/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council and Directive (EU) 2020/1828 of the European Parliament and of the Council and repealing Directive 2001/95/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council and Council Directive 87/357/EEC, **shall apply** to products which are placed on the market or made available on the market, insofar as **European Union law does not contain specific provisions with the same objective** which regulate the safety of the products concerned (Article 2(1) of the GPSR Regulation).

With regard to products subject to specific requirements imposed by EU legislation, harmonization is defined in Article 3(27) of the GPSR Regulation, which shall mean the European Union legislation listed in Annex I to Regulation (EU) 2019/1020 and any other Union legislation harmonizing the conditions for offering products to which the Regulation applies.

The products manufactured by Fabryka Kabli ELPAR spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością, based in Parczew, i.e. cables and wires (depending on the type and application of the product) **are subject to specific requirements imposed by EU harmonisation legislation** listed in Annex I to Regulation (EU) 2019/1020, which contain relevant guidelines, compliance with which ensures the safety of products placed on the market. Thus, we declare that the aforementioned products meet all requirements, in particular with regard to their safety, as defined by the regulations applicable to them:

- Item 22. Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2006 concerning the registration, evaluation, authorization and restriction of chemicals (REACH) and establishing a European Chemicals Agency, (OJ L 396, 30.12.2006, p. 1) (REACH)
- Item 38. Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) No. 305/2011 of 9 March 2011 (MDR), establishing harmonized conditions for the marketing of construction products and repealing Council Directive 89/106/EEC (OJ L 88, 4.4.2011, p. 5) (CPR 305/2011)
- Item 39. Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (OJ L 174, 1.7.2011, p. 88); (RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU).
- Item 54. Directive 2014/35/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 February 2014 on the harmonization of the laws of the Member States relating to the making available on the market of electrical equipment designed for use within certain voltage limits (OJ L 96, 29.3.2014, p. 357) (LVD Directive 2014/35/EU)

At the same time, we ensure that the products we manufacture meet the highest standards of quality, safety, compliance with European and national standards, state-of-the-art knowledge and technology and/or opinions of recognised scientific bodies and expert committees, sector-specific codes of good practice, reasonable consumer expectations with regard to safety, and fulfil the requirements with regard to risks and risk categories covered by occupational health and safety requirements.

In order to meet the safety guidelines, products are subject to all the necessary tests and risk analyses before they are placed on the market and are designed and manufactured in accordance with the general safety requirement, with appropriate documentation and correct labelling to ensure the highest level of safety.
